Re: Application Process for Acquiring a FEMA Modular Housing Unit

As reported at the June 3rd General Council meeting, there are FEMA Modular Housing Units (MHUs) that the Tribe was able to obtain through the Bureau of Indian Affairs. The Membership requested Tribal Council to create an application process with criteria that will establish a list of Tribal Members who would qualify for one (1) of the Modular Housing Units (MHUs) the Tribe received from FEMA.

The following is the process and criteria:

- 1. Complete an Application, which is available at the Tribal Administration Offices.
- 2. Return the completed Application to Sierra Shope or Brenda Torres
- 3. The MHU must be your primary residence and located on the Rancheria.
- 4. Tribal Member must disclose the proposed location to place the MHU on the Rancheria.
- 5. All associated moving costs, including all set-up fees, is be the responsibility of the Tribal Member. The Tribe can assist by creating an A/R account up to \$10,000.00, which must be paid back to the Tribe through Tribal Distribution within eighteen (18) months.
- 6. If the Tribal Member qualifies for HUD assistance, he/she must apply for the HUD assistance.
- 7. When reviewing the completed Applications, special consideration will be given to the status and circumstances below:
 - a. Valley Fire Survivor (who has not received a home yet)
 - b. Long Term Disabled (Federal or State certified in Tribal Program)
 - c. Living in a Condemned Home (home **must** be destroyed and removed)
 - d. Tribal Elder (55 years or older)
 - e. Crowded or Doubled Up living conditions (Tribal Member, with family/kids)
 - f. Crowded or Doubled Up living conditions (Tribal Member, single)
 - g. Have not received Housing Assistance from the Tribe
- 8. Tribal Council will notify the Applicants in writing

We have already received requests in writing, but all applicants must adhere to this application process with the above mentioned criteria in order to be considered for a MHU. Thank you.
