

Tribal Eco Restoration Alliance (TERA) Training Exchange (TREX) Kickoff Tribal Members and Environmental Staff attended the Lake TREX (Training Exchange) Kickoff Conference held at Robinson Rancheria and hosted by the Tribal EcoRestoration Alliance (TERA) on March 14th with a field day on March 15th. This event focused on local capacity building within Lake County and surrounding areas y bringing together individuals interested in improving their fire knowledge and becoming better practitioners of Good Fire. Many local property owners, Lake County staff, State and Federal agencies, and many Tribes from Lake and Mendocino Counties were in attendance. Good Fire was the focus. "Why use Good Fire? ...The use of prescribed fire and cultural burning (good fire) builds resiliency in ecosystems, reduces hazardous fuels, and can enhance public and firefighter safety...There are many benefits to Good Fire." 


Middletown Rancheria Environmental Department Youghi (Earth Day) 2022
