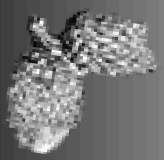


### EVENT RE-CAP

### 2022 Lake County Hazardous Waste Drop off at Middletown Rancheria

Saturday, March 12th 9AM - 1PM

at the Twin Pine Casino Overflow Parking Lot

"When disposed of in the trash or poured down a sink or storm drain, the toxic chemical components in products like paint, turpentine, acid or lye-based cleaners, household and car batteries, pesticides, and herbicides will damage the environment.

These items end up in Clear Lake or other waterways, endangering the health of all - children, wildlife, pets, and the environment."

**REMEMBER:**

- Propane tanks (any compressed cylinders), maximum 5 gallons.
- Be prepared to show identification as a Lake County resident.
- Electronics and used oil are accepted at no charge at Lake County Waste Solutions and Southlake Refuse & Recycling.
- State law prohibits delivery of more than 15 gallons per vehicle.

**Hazardous Materials that can be Dropped-off at HAZ-DROP include:**
